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Marketplace Affordability Program State Subsidy Report Guide

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Overview

This guide provides details for the new state subsidy reports that will replace the 820B (New Mexico Premium Assistance, NMPA), 820C (Native American Premium Assistance, NAPA), and 820D (Medical Transition Premium Relief, MTPR), as well as the SOPA (State-out-of-Pocket Assistance) report. The four state subsidies, administered in partnership with the New Mexico Health Care Authority (HCA), are designed to ease the financial burden of health insurance premiums and out-of-pocket costs for eligible residents and facilitate broader access to coverage. They are components of the Marketplace Affordability Program, which is funded through the Health Care Affordability Fund.¹

Subsidy Summary

1. New Mexico Premium Assistance (NMPA)

- **Purpose:** To reduce monthly health insurance premiums.
- **Eligibility:** New Mexico residents eligible for Marketplace coverage who either meet all federal PTC criteria except the household income requirements or are lawfully present but not eligible for the federal PTC.

2. Native American Premium Assistance (NAPA)

- **Purpose:** To reduce total cost responsibility for eligible Native American individuals.
- **Eligibility:** Members of federally-recognized tribes who qualify for APTCs, with household income up to 400% of the federal poverty level.

3. Medicaid Transition Premium Relief (MTPR)

- **Purpose:** To support individuals transitioning from Medicaid to insurance coverage through the Marketplace. The one-time payment is intended to create a 'free' first month and ensure effectuation of coverage through the Marketplace.

- **Eligibility:** Consumers who are no longer eligible for Medicaid and are enrolling in Marketplace plans, with household incomes up to 400% of the federal poverty level.

4. State Out-of-Pocket Premium Assistance (SOPA)

- **Purpose:** To provide enhanced coverage and the greatest savings on out-of-pocket costs—including deductibles, copays, and coinsurance—through specially designated Turquoise-level plans.
- **Eligibility:** New Mexico residents who qualify for APTCs, with a household income up to 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).

Timeline:

1. On the 2nd of the month (or the next business day), the **Subsidy Current Month Report** is generated for the upcoming month's subsidies.
2. On the 2nd of the month (or the next business day), the **Subsidy Adjustment Month Report** is generated for any changes generated since the last Report.
3. On the 2nd of the month (or the next business day), the **SOPA Current Month Report** is generated for the upcoming month.
4. On the 2nd of the month (or the next business day), the **SOPA Adjustment Month Report** is generated for any changes generated since the last report.
5. Example:
 - a. On 3/2/26, the Subsidy Current Month Report is generated for State Subsidies for the month of March.
 - b. On 3/2/26, the Subsidy Adjustment Month Report is generated with changes to January and February subsidies that occurred since the 2/2/26 report was generated.
 - c. On 3/2/26, the SOPA Current Month Report is generated for State Subsidies for the month of March.
 - d. On 3/2/26, the Subsidy Adjustment Month Report is generated with changes to January and February subsidies that occurred since the 2/2/26 report was generated.
4. The reports will be generated by BeWell staff and delivered to the Health Care Authority for review and approval.
5. After approval by HCA, BeWell will issue the reports to the carrier and HCA will issue payments to the carrier for the monthly subsidies. ²
6. Example:
 - a. On 3/2/26, BeWell submits NMPA, NAPA, MTPR, and SOPA reports for the month of March to HCA.

- b. Payment amounts for NMPA, NAPA, MTPR, and SOPA related to March coverage will be included in the Notice of Payment.
 - c. By a target date of 3/31/26, all payments for March coverage month will be disbursed to the issuers.
- 7. Payments are targeted for disbursement by the last business day of each month.
